## COPERNICUS - Deeper (LP)

Many writers have labeled Copernicus and his work "weird" or "hard to describe". It is neither. Copernicus is a multi-dimensional man, kind of like David Byrne without the puke factor. A Laurie Anderson with guts and vision is more like it.

Deeper, his third album continues his visionary quest to show that nothing exists and that of all the follies in the universe man is the biggest. This album (recorded live and in the studio) delivers his vision in a distinct and accessible fashion. His poems (stream of consciousness outbursts) which form the lyrical content address everything from the foolishness of government to mans belief in humanity. A very convincing singer, he backs these visions with a large musical ensemble capable of throwing it down in any musical mode. Akin to Henry Cows legendary performances with even more bite. If you're waiting to meet an extra terrestrial, or just bored of Earthly matters, lie down, connect up the Tabasco sauce intravenously, put on Deeper.
