LP "Nothing exists" he is backed by a 13 piece band. You

a very pretty songs with a great melody line and a superb
instrumental backing. My mistake is that I'm not able to

is the lyric sheet in "Victim of the sky", but I still
find it hard to understand and hard to swallow. There is
no doubt, both records are very interesting, but nothing
for you Punks, Psychedelic Freaks, Beatniks and Rock'n'
Rollers, but the others will love Copernicus, the Rock
poet and philosophical rebel.
